


## How do I review a student assessment attempt

This document provides instructions on how to review detailed individual student attempts on a course assessment. Following these steps will allow you to view the quiz or test as the student completed it.

1. Click the **Reports & Grades** tab and then click **Grader Report**.
2. Scroll to the grade column for the assessment you want to view.
3. Click the **magnifying glass icon** to the right of the grade. Navigate will then display the test details for the student, including the date the test was taken, the time it took to complete, and the grade. 4. You can click a question number under Assessment navigation to review a question, or you can use the Next button at the bottom of the screen to review the questions in order.
5. Click the **Make comment or override points** option to adjust the credit a student receives for the question
